



## **Whitesboro Riding Club Rodeo Royalty Obligations/Contract**

The Whitesboro Riding Club Queen, Princess, Jr Princess & Buckarett/Buckaroo will be obliged to represent the Whitesboro Riding Club (WRC) from the time the title is won at the 2026 WRC Annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Rodeo, until new winners are announced at the 2027 Rodeo. All title holders are expected to appear groomed and looking their best while wearing modest western clothing (“Official Western Attire”) their crown, sash and buckle when appearing and making representations as WRC Rodeo Royalty. Title holders are always expected to represent and appear this way through out, the Whitesboro Rodeo and other affiliated events.

As Representatives of the WRC/ Whitesboro Rodeo, title holders will:

- Exhibit good, honest, and positive behavior always.
- Refrain from using profanity and inappropriate language.
- Refrain from smoking/vaping, drinking alcohol and / or using illegal substances.
- Not having any visible tattoos (must be covered by clothing) no piercing other than ears.
- Have hair color only of natural colors i.e. Blonde, Red, Brunette. (not blue, green, purple, pink, etc.)
- Not become engaged, married, or pregnant during the term of reign.
- Not exhibit public displays of affection with a boyfriend or companion of that nature, while at recognized events.
- May not compete for other Rodeo Royalty titles without consulting with the WRC Royalty Chair first.
- Not create social media accounts using the WRC title. All social media accounts for WRC Royalty are to be maintained by WRC officials and /or the designated chairperson or coordinator.
- Anything a title holder has made using the WRC Rodeo title/name/logo/ must be approved by the WRC Royalty Chair, this includes chaps, any articles of clothing or other items.
- Pictures and details of all event representation are expected and need to be sent by email or text to the Chair for use on official social media accounts

WRC Royalty are required to attend the following events:

- All WRC 4<sup>th</sup> July Rodeo events as contestants & representatives:
- Royalty Contest Events
- Rodeo Grand Entries & Performances
- Rodeo “Slack night” in concession stand
- Gainesville Rodeo (July)
- Saint Jo Rodeo & Prade (August)
- Collinsville Pioneer Days Parade (September)
- Whitesboro Peanut Festival Parade (October)
- Whitesboro Christmas Parade (December)
- 25% of club events

In addition to the event list above, title holders will be responsible for representing the WRC at:



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- Queen/ Princess- 3 additional events of their choice I.E. Rodeos, Parades, Community events.
- Jr. Princess/Buckarett – 1 minimum

Title holder or not limited to the above representations.

If for any reason these obligations cannot be fulfilled, the title holder or authorized guardian must contact the Chair to state why the obligation cannot be met. In default of not fulfilling the obligations to the WRC, the title holder may lose their title and prizes. The title and prizes will then be given to the First Runner Up in that division. Title holders will receive their awarded scholarship after their obligations are fulfilled and their title reign is complete.

9.  If someone other than a parent is acting as a guardian, a signed letter needs to be included with the entry form appointing and authorizing said guardian.

NOTE- Entries not received by the stated deadline date April 18th, 2026 or that are not complete will be dismissed. Entries that do not include all the required items will not be considered complete. Entry fee is non-refundable once the contest has started.

# Whitesboro Riding Club Contest Rules, Qualifications and Guidelines & Entry Requirement Checklist

## Queen, Princess, Jr Princess, Buckette/Buckaroo

Contest Rules, Qualifications and Guidelines and the Rodeo Royalty Obligations / Contract **MUST BE READ** in full before entering this contest. Interested parties must be able to meet and adhere to these rules and requirements. Not doing so may deny one the right to compete for a Whitesboro Rodeo Club Title.

Whitesboro Rodeo Club and Queen, Princess and Buckette/Buckaroo title holders are not eligible to compete in the Whitesboro Riding Club (WRC) Royalty contest for a minimum of one year after the end of their reign. Prior WRC titleholders are eligible to compete in the appropriate age groups in the following years but may not compete for an age division title that they have previously held.

### **Age Divisions:**

Queen (14-18)    Princess (10-13)    Jr. Princess (6-9)    Buckette/Buckaroo (5 & under)

### **TO BE ELIGIBLE, CONTESTANTS AND TITLE HOLDERS MUST:**

- Have been born a female and compete as a female (Jr. Princess - Queen Age Divisions).
- Be a legal resident of the state of Texas and the United States.
- Be a student in good standing if applicable.
- Not be, have been or become married, nor have a marriage that has been nullified.
- Not be, have been or become pregnant.
- Not consume alcohol or smoke, vape or do any illegal drugs.
- Not have any visible tattoos (must be covered by clothing) or visible piercings other than ears.
- Have hair that is of a natural color. (Red, Blonde, Brunette, not blue, green, pink, purple, etc.)
- Not have been or become convicted of a misdemeanor or felony of any kind or have any other involvement in any type of delinquent or criminal activity.
- Have read and submitted all signed and completed entry forms, consents, waivers, required documentation, and release forms prior to competition
  - ✓ Represent themselves for the Whitesboro Riding Club
  - ✓ Consult with the WRC Rodeo Chairman/Director if currently holding another title to determine eligibility.
  - ✓ Attend every event on the contest schedule and prompt. Any exceptions must be approved by the contest director. Failure to appear at an event can result in contest disqualification.

Provide a horse for horsemanship, each Rodeo Grand Entry during the rodeo, and the Parade if contestant rides horseback in the Parade. The horse does not need to be the contestant's own horse and can be borrowed. Must always have current Coggins



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available. **Please note that NO horse stalls are available at the WRC rodeo arena grounds. Contestants are responsible for finding/making any necessary arrangements needed for their horse.**

- ✓ Contestants and their parents/guardians/guests must abide by all rules and regulations of the contest and exhibit good behavior and sportsmanship. Immediate dismissal and disqualification will be enforced if any contestant/parent/guardian/guest demonstrates poor sportsmanship, being disrespectful to others, argumentative, or performing unruly behavior.
- ✓ All contestants and their parents/guardians/guests or anyone acting on behalf of a contestant should not approach or communicate in ANY way with judges at ANY time. All questions must be directed to the Contest Coordinator or their designee for clarification. The names of contest judges are not disclosed prior to the contest.
- ✓ All the contestants **MUST** attend the Awards Ceremony after Coronation to receive gifts or awards they earn. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of gifts or awards. Any exceptions must be pre-approved by the pageant's director.

**ALL COTESTANTS MUST BE A MEMBER OF WRC FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES THE MEMBERSHIP IS \$15 FOR INDIVIDUALS AND \$25 FOR FAMILIES.**

**If the contest rules are not followed or are broken at any time, the chairman of the contest may disqualify and remove a contestant on the grounds of breaking the rules provided to them prior to entering the contest. WRC title holders must follow these same rules and guidelines before and during their reign of title. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of their title and prizes.**

### **MONEY RAISED**

**QUEENS** are required to raise **\$2500**, including a minimum of 150 ticket  
**PRINCESSES** are required to raise **\$2000**, including a minimum of 100 tickets.



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**JR PRINCESSES and BUCKARETTE/BUCKAROO** are required to raise **\$1000**, including a minimum of 50 tickets.

### **TICKETS/ TICKET SALES**

Each contestant will be issued 50 tickets at the Check in / Orientation with a QR code for online ticket sales. Tickets issued only with completed application turned in. Each contestant is responsible for ALL tickets in her possession as well as monies collected by her or anyone acting on her behalf whether for ticket sales or donations. Restocking tickets can be accomplished by the contestant contacting the Royalty Coordinator and surrendering all monies collected for ticket sales and donations to that point. All contestants must report to the Whitesboro Riding Club Arena on **Wednesday, July 1<sup>st</sup> no later than 7pm** to submit all monies collected as well as any remaining unsold tickets to the Royalty Coordinator.

### **SPONSORSHIPS & DONATIONS**

Each contestant will be issued two sponsorship packets. In addition to selling tickets, contestants will have to sell a minimum of 2 sponsorships for WRC Rodeo as well as take any donations (WRC is a 501(c)(3)). Contestants will be credited for 100% of the total sponsorship amount received. The higher the amount of money raised, the better! It's the contestant's responsibility to ensure that the sponsors fill out the packet and turn in collected monies at our check-ins. Royalty contestants are responsible for ensuring that their name is on the sponsorship form to receive credit. Sponsorships are due no later than **May 31<sup>st</sup>**; however, donations can be taken up until tickets are turned in.

### **HORSEMANSHIP**

All contestants will compete in horsemanship, except for Buckarette. Each contestant will be allowed ONE chaperone in the staging area of the arena at horsemanship. All other parents, guests, etc. Can be seated in the bleachers **AWAY** from the judges. If the judges feel as if the child's horse is unsafe for the child or others during the pattern, they will be kindly dismissed from the arena. The current title holder in each age division will ride first. Contestants will go in the order they are given. Bring a horse that helps you display your level of skill and talent. Contestants and their horses will ride the given pattern for their age division following the stated instructions and be judged accordingly.

### **HORSEMANSHIP PATTERNS**

- ❖ The Queen pattern will be given out morning of horsemanship.
- ❖ The Princess and Jr Princess patterns will be given out a week prior to the competition.

Riders in these age groups will be judged on their riding skills, abilities, posture, smile, etc., details of the pattern, and the cleanliness/ appearance of themselves, their horse, and tack.

### **APPEARANCE/ PERSONALITY & INTERVIEW**

Contestants should be able to introduce themselves by giving their name, age, interests, and activities to the judges. All age groups will be asked age-



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appropriate questions about the sport of rodeo, the WRC, personal interest, and horses. The interview should last 5-10 minutes

**NOTE-** The appearance and personality will be judged throughout the horsemanship and interview; it will also be judged throughout the first night of the rodeo by the judges.

### **WARDROBE NEEDS**

- **Horsemanship-** Dark wash blue jeans or jeans to match your outfit. Felt Hat, Boots, and belt- **JUDGED**
- **Interview-** Interview outfit (Queen- shirt, Jacket, Vest, Jeans, or skirt, Felt Hat, Boots, and Belt) **JUDGED**
- **Grand Entry- Western** Shirt. Felt Hat, Jeans, Boots, and Belt. **JUDGED**
- **On Rodeo Grounds- Same** attire as Grand Entry. (While we understand it is hot and the felt hat will have to come off at times) **JUDGED**

**Please remember the judges will be watching you and how you are dressed/interact with others!**

**If a contestant needs help securing wardrobe items, please contact the Royalty committee and all efforts will be made to assist contestants.**

### **RODEO GRAND ENTRIES**

All title holders and contestants will ride in the rodeo grand entry each night of the WRC Rodeo. Official rodeo attire is expected ALL nights. Parents, Friend, and other guests should remain orderly behind the arena and not enter/clog the alleyway as the girls wait to ride each night.
