



## Whitesboro Riding Club Rodeo Royalty Obligations/Contract

The 2025-2026 Whitesboro Riding Club Teen, Princess, Junior Princess & Buckarett / Buckaroo will be obligated to represent the Whitesboro Riding Club (WRC) from the time the title is won at the 2025 WRC through the time the event is held, and new winners are announced at the 2025 WRC. All title holders are expected to appear groomed and looking their best while wearing modest western clothing (“Official Western Dress”), their crown, sash and buckle when appearing and making representations as WRC Rodeo Royalty. Title holders are always expected to represent and appear this way at the Whitesboro Rodeo and other affiliated events.

As representatives of the Whitesboro Riding Club/ Whitesboro Rodeo, title holders will:

- Exhibit good, honest, and positive behavior always.
- Refrain from using profanity and inappropriate language.
- Refrain from smoking, drinking alcohol and/or using illegal substances.
- Not have any visible tattoos (must be covered by clothing) or piercings other than ears.
- Have hair color only of natural colors (Red, Blonde, Brunette, not blue, green, purple, pink, etc.)
- Not become engaged, married, or pregnant during the term of title reign.
- Not let a boyfriend or companion be known about at appearances or on any social media accounts.
- Not exhibit public displays of affection with a boyfriend or companion of that nature.
- Not compete for other Rodeo Royalty titles without consulting with the WRC Royalty Director first.
- Not create social media accounts using the WRC title. All social media accounts for WRC Queen, Teen, Princess, and Junior Princess are to be maintained by WRC officials and/or the designated chairperson(s) or coordinator(s).
- Anything a title holder has made using the WRC Rodeo title/name/logo must be approved by the WRC Director/Chairman or another representative of the WRC, this includes chaps, any articles of clothing or other items.
- Pictures and details of all event representations are expected and need to be emailed or sent via text to the Director for use on the official social media accounts for WRC.

The following representations by 2025-2026 WRC Royalty are required to attend:

- Gainesville Rodeo (July)
- Saint Jo Rodeo Parade (August)
- Whitesboro Christmas Parade (December)

- Whitesboro Peanut Festival Parade(October)
- Collinsville Pioneer Days Parade (September)
- 2026 WRC 4th of July Rodeo Events:
  - 2026 Royalty Contest Events
  - 2026 Rodeo Grand Entries & Performances
  - 2026 Rodeo 'Slack' Night

In **addition** to the event listed above, title holders will be responsible for representing the Whitesboro Riding Club at:

- Rodeo/Grand Entry
  - Queen/ Princess – 3 minimum
  - Jr Princess/Buckarett – 1 minimum
- At least 2 additional Parades.
- Participate in 2 Community Projects/Activities/Events (Attend/Assist with a local Rodeo, school or community activity, benefit, fundraiser, or other event)

**Additional appearances may be requested and/or offered by the WRC Royalty Coordinator(s). Title holders are not limited to the above representations.**

If for any reason these obligations cannot be fulfilled, the title holder or authorized guardian must contact the Director to state why the obligations cannot be fulfilled. In default of not fulfilling the obligations to represent WRC, the title holder may lose their title and prizes. The title and prizes will then be given to the First Runner Up in that division. Title holders will receive their scholarship checks after their obligations are fulfilled and their title reign is complete.

If a pandemic or other crisis causing event cancellations occurs, title holders will not be held liable for attendance at those events. Title holders and/or their designated guardians should always first contact the WRC Rodeo Royalty Director/Chairperson/Coordinator(s) with any questions or issues.

# Whitesboro Riding Club Contest Rules, Qualifications and Guidelines & Entry Requirement Checklist

## Queen, Princess, Jr Princess, Buckerette/Buckaroo

**Contest Rules, Qualifications and Guidelines and the Rodeo Royalty Obligations / Contract MUST BE READ in full before entering this contest. Interested parties must be able to meet and adhere to these rules and requirements. Not doing so may deny one the right to compete for a Whitesboro Rodeo Club Title.**

Whitesboro Rodeo Club and Queen, Princess and Buckerette/Buckaroo title holders are not eligible to compete in the Whitesboro Riding Club (WRC) Royalty contest for a minimum of one year after the end of their reign. Prior WRC titleholders are eligible to compete in the appropriate age groups the following years but may not compete for an age division title that they have previously held.

**Age Divisions:** Three age divisions, ages 5-18. Age is considered the first day of the Pageant.

Queen(14-18)      Princess (10-13)      Jr. Princess(6-9)      Buckerette/Buckaroo(5 & under)

**Entry Fee:** \$25 for all age divisions. Checks should be made payable to the WRC.

### **TO BE ELIGIBLE, CONTESTANTS AND TITLE HOLDERS MUST:**

- Have been born a female and compete as a female (Jr. Princess - Queen Age Divisions).
- Be a legal resident of the state of Texas and the United States.
- Be a student in good standing if applicable.
- Not be, have been or become married, nor have had a marriage nullified.
- Not be, have been or become pregnant.
- Not consume alcohol or smoke, vape or do any illegal drugs.
- Not have any visible tattoos (must be covered by clothing) or visible piercings other than ears.
- Have hair that is of a natural color. (Red, Blonde, Brunette, *not* blue, green, pink, purple, etc.)
- Not have been or become convicted of a misdemeanor or felony of any kind or have any other involvement in any type of delinquent or criminal activity.
- Have read and submitted all signed and completed entry forms, consents, waivers, required documentation, and release forms prior to competition.

- Represent themselves for the Whitesboro Rodeo Club.
- Consult with the WRC Rodeo Royalty Chairman/Director if currently holding another title to determine eligibility.
- Attend every event on the contest schedule and be prompt. Any exceptions must be approved by the contest director. Failure to appear at an event can result in contest disqualification.
- Provide a horse for Horsemanship, each Rodeo Grand Entry during the rodeo, and the Parade *if* contestants will ride horseback in the Parade. The horse does not need to be the contestant's own horse and can be borrowed. Please have the horse's current Coggins available. **Please note that NO horse stalls are available at the WRC rodeo arena grounds. Contestants are responsible for finding/making any necessary arrangements needed for their horse.**
- Contestants and their parents/guardians/guests must abide by all rules and regulations of the contest and exhibit good behavior and sportsmanship. Any contestant/parent/guardian/guest demonstrating poor sportsmanship or being disrespectful, argumentative, or unruly will be asked to leave which will result in immediate disqualification.
- All contestants and their parents/guardians/guests or anyone acting on behalf of a contestant should not approach or communicate in ANY way with judges at ANY time. All questions must be directed to the Contest Coordinator(s) or their designee for clarification. The names of contest judges are not disclosed prior to the contest.
- All contestants **must** attend the Awards Ceremony after Coronation to receive gifts or awards they earn. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of gifts or awards. Any exceptions must be pre-approved by the pageant director.

**ALL CONTESTANTS MUST BE A MEMBER OF WRC FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES  
THE MEMBERSHIP IS \$15 for Individuals and \$25 for Families**

**If the contest rules are not followed or are broken at any time, the chairman of the contest may disqualify and remove a contestant on the grounds of breaking the rules provided to them prior to entering the contest. WRC title holders must follow these same rules and guidelines before and during their reign of title. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of their title and prizes.**

### **JUDGING AND SCORING BREAKDOWN, BY AGE DIVISION**

#### **MONEY RAISED**

**QUEENS** are required to raise \$2,500, including a minimum of 150 tickets.

**PRINCESSES** are required to raise \$2,000, including a minimum of 100 tickets.

**JR PRINCESSES** are required to raise \$1,500, including a minimum of 75 tickets.

**BUCKARETTE/BUCKAROO** are required to raise \$500, including a minimum of 25 tickets.

After receipt of complete entry, the contest director will then advise of arrangements for the contestant to receive tickets. Contestants will earn a SET number of points by selling the required minimum.

#### **TICKETS / TICKET SALES**

Each Contestant will be issued 50 tickets at the Check in/Orientation with a QR code for online ticket sales. Tickets issued with completed application turned in. Each Contestant is responsible for ALL tickets in her possession as well as monies collected by her or anyone acting on her behalf whether for ticket sales or donations. Restocking of tickets can be accomplished by the contestant contacting the Royalty Coordinator and surrendering all monies collected for ticket sales and donations to that point. All contestants must report to the Whitesboro Riding Club rodeo grounds on **Wednesday, July 2nd at 5:00 PM** to submit all monies collected as well as any remaining unsold tickets.

#### **SPONSORSHIPS & DONATIONS**

Each contestant will be issued with 2 Sponsorship packets. In addition to selling tickets, contestants can sell sponsorships for WRC Rodeo as well as take any donations (WRC is a 501(c)(3)). Contestants will be credited for 60% of the total sponsorship amount received. The higher amount of money raised, the better! It is the contestants

responsibility to ensure that the sponsors fill out the packet and turn in collected monies at our check ins. Royalty Contestants are responsible for ensuring that their name is on the sponsorship form to receive credit. Sponsorships are due no later than **May 31st**, however donations can be taken up until tickets are turned in.

### **HORSEMANSHIP**

All contestants will compete in Horsemanship. **All contestants will wear blue jeans and white shirts for this portion of the contest. Each contestant will be allowed ONE chaperone in the staging area of the arena at Horsemanship. All other parents, guests, etc. can be seated in the bleachers AWAY from judges.** Contestants failing to exhibit control over their horse at any time will be removed from this phase of competition for the safety of all participants.

The current title holder in each age division will ride first. Contestants will go in the order they are given. Bring a horse that helps you display your level of skill and talent. Contestants and their horses will ride the given pattern for their age division following the stated instructions and be judged accordingly.

### **HORSEMANSHIP PATTERNS**

- Queen and Princess contestants will ride the same pattern.
- Jr. Princesses will have a different pattern.
- Buckette/Buckaroos **do not** ride a pattern.

Queen, Princess, and Jr Princess contestants will ride their pattern, ride to the judges to be asked 2 questions chosen and prepared by the judges. Questions will be regarding their knowledge of horses, the horse industry and/or their personal background dealing with horses. Queen, Princess contestants will be asked to dismount & remount. Jr Princesses will not be asked to dismount. Riders in these age groups will be judged on their riding skills and abilities, posture, smile, etc., details of the pattern, their response to questions and the cleanliness/appearance of themselves and their horse and tack.

### **APPEARANCE/MODELING, SPEECH/Q&A, IMPROMPTU QUESTIONS**

Contestants will model in a "T" pattern walked on the floor. For the first segment, contestants should wear traditional western dress attire of dress or skirt and top/jacket nature, western hat, and western boots. Leather is NOT required. Judges will want to see how well the contestant wears their clothing. They will look for good fit and their confidence and positivity as well as their personality overall while modeling. Contestants should be able to introduce themselves

by giving their name, age, interests and activities and other information on a microphone. They should be prepared to speak about their outfit, giving a brief description of its details and designers/makers. Following the Queen and Princess contestant's self-introduction and outfit descriptions, they will then give their prepared Speech. At the end of their Speech, they will be asked 1 impromptu question. (Rules pertaining to Speech can be found below.) Princess and Buckarett/Buckaroo contestants will be asked age appropriate Impromptu questions for the Q&A portion of the contest.

*Self-introductions and outfit descriptions will serve as part of the Personality scores. Impromptu questions will be scored in the Interview Category.*

After the first segment of modeling, contestants will be given 15 minutes to change in the room provided by the (host venue decided by WRC). Everyone must change in this room to stay on schedule. No exceptions! The second segment of this portion of the contest will be the contestant's choice of trendy western fashion. The contestant may wear their favorite trendy/fashion forward outfit. Blue jeans ARE allowed in this portion of the contest. Be sure to use good taste and creativity. The contestant's introduction, outfit description and modeling style will be judged as it was in the first segment. In western dress it is a time to be more serious while having fun as Rodeo Royalty. Modeling trendy outfits is a time to show a little more flair and have a little more fun. Include something fun about yourself in your introduction! Before completion of this segment of competition, contestants will be asked a few impromptu questions.

Please note that part of the Appearance score will include judging of the outfit worn at Interview.

**SPEECH – QUEEN, PRINCESS & JR. PRINCESS**

Each contestant's speech must be between 1-2 minutes. Considerably less or considerably longer will be cause for point deductions. A few seconds either way will be dismissed. Each contestant should be able to speak on a microphone. Contestants will present their speech created from the given topics. Content, expressions, voice clarity, and posture will be part of the judging.

**QUESTION & ANSWER (Q&A) BUCKARETTES**

Contestants will be scored on their fluidity and confidence in speaking along with their response to questions they are asked. Their voice clarity, smile, expressions, and posture will also be considered. As stated above, the questions and answers asked during the modeling contest will be judged for Q&A.

**INTERVIEW/PERSONALITY**

All contestants attire will be judged and scored at Interview as part of the Appearance total score. Queen, Princess, Jr Princess contestants will have a public interview with Judges following the modeling. Judges will ask questions and have a brief conversation with each contestant regarding Rodeo, horses, personal interests, and activities, etc. Buckaretttes/Buckaroo Contestants will have a group interview. Interviews will last 5-10 minutes.

**RODEO GRAND ENTRIES**

All title holders and contestants will ride in the Rodeo Grand Entry each night of the WRC Rodeo. Official Rodeo Attire is expected ALL nights. Parents, friends, and other guests should remain orderly behind the arena and not enter/clog the alleyway as the girls wait to ride each night. Stay out of the way!
